FALLS FROM **ROOFS**
CAN BE PREVENTED!



- ☒ Wear a harness and always stay connected
- ☒ Make sure harness fits
- ☒ Use guardrails or lifelines
- ☒ Inspect all fall protection equipment before use
- ☒ Guard or cover all holes, openings, and skylights



Do Not:

- ☒ Disconnect from the lifeline
- ☒ Work around unprotected openings or skylights
- ☒ Use defective equipment

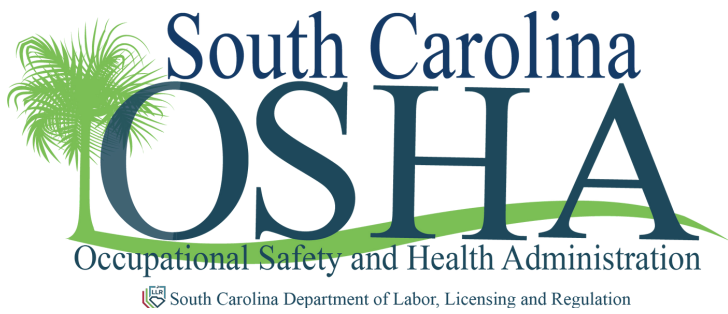
Plan, ahead to get the job done safely

Provide, the right roof equipment

FALLS FROM LADDERS CAN BE PREVENTED!



- ☒ Choose the right ladder
- ☒ Maintain three points of contact
- ☒ Secure the ladder
- ☒ Always face the ladder

Plan, ahead to get the job done safely

Provide, the right roof equipment

Train, everyone to use the equipment safely



Do Not:

- ☒ Stand on top or on the top step of a stepladder
- ☒ Overreach
- ☒ Place the ladder on unlevel footing



FALLS FROM SCAFFOLDS CAN BE PREVENTED!



- ☒ Use fully planked scaffolds
- ☒ Ensure proper access to scaffolds
- ☒ Plumb and level
- ☒ Complete ALL guardrails
- ☒ Ensure stable footing
- ☒ Inspect before use (by competent person)

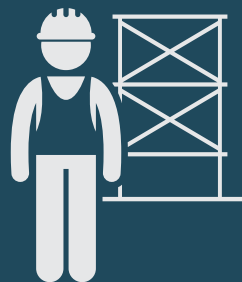

- ☒ Stand on guardrails
- ☒ Climb cross-braces
